I am excited to share details about Ainslie Wood's upcoming **Global Discovery Day** which will take place on **Tuesday 1<sup>st</sup> April**. It promises to be an exciting day filled with adventure, exploration, and discovery as we immerse the children in all things geography!

We have planned a variety of engaging activities for each year group, aimed at encouraging curiosity and creativity as the children explore different aspects of geography.

**Blue and Green Quads: "Guess Where I'm From?"**

Children are invited to wear **traditional clothing** or items that reflect their cultural heritage. During the day, they will talk about the clothing they are wearing, where it comes from, as well as popular foods, weather, and traditions.

**Red and Yellow Quads: "The Journey of the T-Shirt"**

**Children in years 3-6 will need to wear non-uniform preferably a t-shirt from home with a label inside.** This will form part of their learning for the day (no new purchases are required).

They will be exploring the journey of their clothing by using the information on the labels and investigating where in the world their clothes have travelled from.

In addition to the year group-specific focusses, all students will also have the opportunity to participate in some whole-school geography-themed activities: from investigating their routes home to raising awareness of endangered species.
