Safeguarding means protecting children from harm, ensuring they are safe at home, at school, and in the wider community. This includes protecting them from:

- Physical, emotional, or sexual abuse
- Neglect or unsafe living situations
- Bullying
- Harmful content or contact online

👩🏫 Who Keeps Children Safe at School?

All our staff are trained to spot signs of abuse or harm and know how to report concerns. We have a dedicated **Designated Safeguarding Lead (DSL)** and deputies who handle all safeguarding matters.
