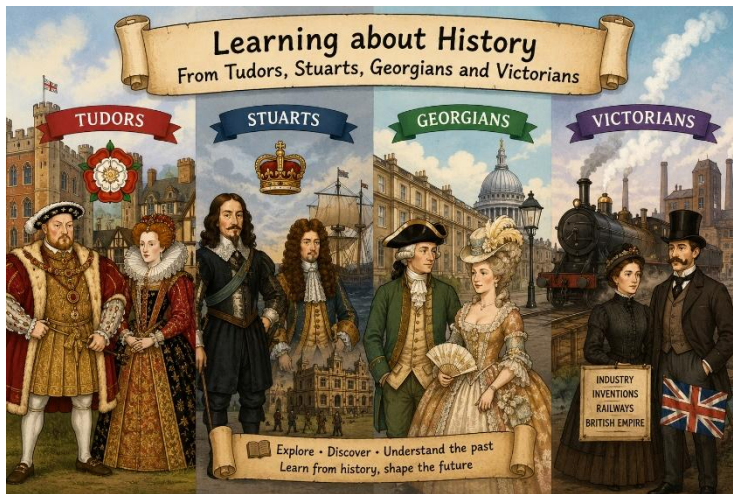


Year 6 Autumn term

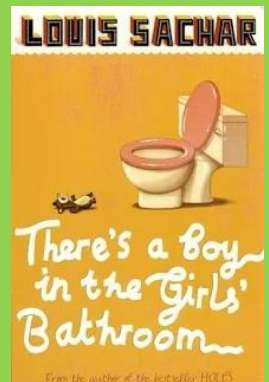
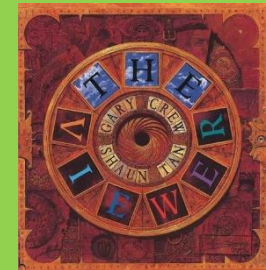
